1 Peter 2: 2-10

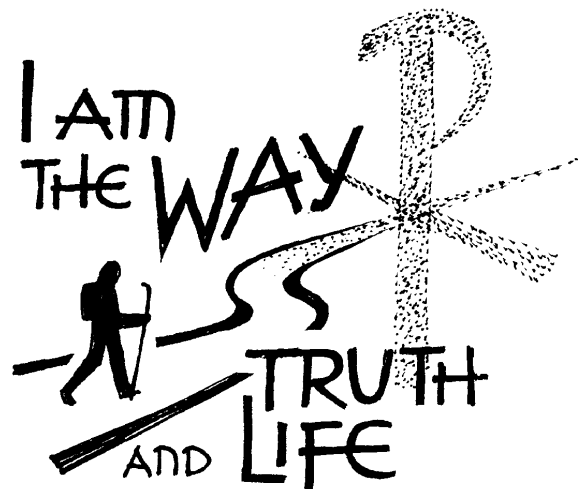
Our call to witness
