Elijah's prophetic spirit is passed to Elisha

Knowing that Elijah was on his final journey, Elisha stayed faithfully with him. It was given to him to witness Elijah's great power. Elijah offered to grant the young man what he wished. Elisha asked that the prophet's great spirit would pass to him. This gift was confirmed when Elisha was enabled to see his master taken away in a whirlwind by a chariot of fire. Elisha's grief at the loss of Elijah was very great.

2 Corinthians 4: 3-6

The glory of God—in the face of Jesus Christ

Here Paul writes of 'the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ who is the image of God'. He declares that it is God Himself who has shone His light in our hearts, giving us 'the light of the glory of God...in the face of Jesus Christ'. This is a description of Christian experience and the witness that believers have for the world.

Mark 9: 2-9

Jesus as He really is

On a mountain top, Jesus is seen by three of His disciples, transfigured in light and talking with Moses, the law giver and Elijah, the prophet - the great ones whose work He had come to fulfil. Peter wanted to build shelters for each of them but a cloud covered them and a voice declared Jesus to be God's beloved Son. When the cloud cleared Jesus was again alone with His disciples but they had seen Him as He truly is.
