We give thanks:

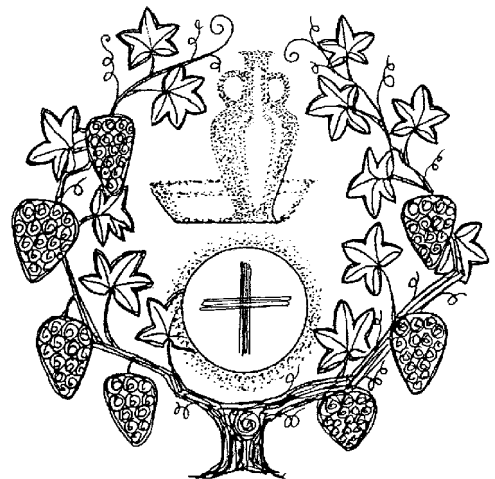
*for all that comes to us to sustain us -
