**Isaiah 25: 6-9**

**A time of joy for all peoples**

Isaiah here foretells a time when God will welcome all peoples into His presence; there will be no more death; the Lord will wipe away the tears from all faces. This will be a time to be 'be glad and rejoice in His salvation'.

**Revelation 21: 1-6a**

**A new heaven and a new earth**

Here we have a vision of the coming time when God will be among His people; when death, mourning, crying and pain will be no more - for He is 'making all things new'.

**John 11: 32-44**

**Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead**

Jesus shared in the grief of Martha and Mary at the death of their brother Lazarus - who had been a friend of Jesus Himself. Martha and others believed that, if Jesus had arrived there in time, Lazarus would not have died. Jesus prayed to His Father and then called to Lazarus to come out from the grave. Martha was concerned as her brother had been in the tomb for four days. Lazarus did come out and was freed from the grave clothes that were around him. He was free to live again!
