## **Isaiah 6: 1-8**

### **Called to serve**

These lines describe a beautiful vision of heaven and the presence and sight of God. Then there is the call, of cleansed and blessed human beings, to serve the Lord - and the willing response.

## **1 Corinthians 15: 1-11**

### **The Good News - and Paul's call to spread that news**

In this letter Paul outlines the message of the life, death and resurrection - the good news that Paul had been called, by the risen Lord Himself, to proclaim. He, who had been persecuting believing members of the church, was now - by God's grace - willing and enabled to spread this good news.

## **Luke 5: 1-11**

### **A miraculous catch of fish - and fishermen are called to follow Jesus**

Luke recounts how, in order to teach the crowds that were gathered on the beach more easily, Jesus got into the boat of Simon, a fisherman, and asked him to take the boat a little way from the shore. After teaching the crowd, Jesus asked Simon to go to deeper water and let down the nets. Simon said they had worked all night and caught nothing but he did as Jesus asked. There were so many fish that partners in another boat had to come to help. Both boats were filled! Simon was overwhelmed and asked Jesus' forgiveness for his unworthiness. Jesus told him that he would in future, be 'catching' people. From that time Simon and his friends, James and John, left their nets and followed Jesus.
