Liturgy of the Palms

Luke 19: 28-40

On His way to Jerusalem, arriving near to the Mount of Olives, Jesus told two of His disciples to go to the nearby village of Bethany and to bring Him a young colt, never yet ridden. This they did and as Jesus came, riding on the colt from the Mount of Olives, the crowds welcomed Him, praising God with joy for all the deeds of power that they had seen. The Pharisees wanted to silence them but Jesus said, 'I tell you, if these were silent the stones would cry out.'

Liturgy of the Passion

Isaiah 50: 4-9a

The Suffering Servant's unwavering trust in God

Throughout all His sufferings, even when unjustly and cruelly treated, the servant of God remains faithful to His mission, trusting in God at all times.

Philippians 2: 5-11

Called to be Christ-like

In these words, which became one of the hymns of the Early Church, the apostle Paul calls on Christians to be like their Lord. Although Jesus was great, He was humble and obedient to God, His Father, willing to do His will, no matter what the cost, even to the point of death.

Luke 23: 1-56

The Passion of our Lord

In a dramatic presentation, the suffering and death of Jesus are enacted - from His trial, His condemnation by the crowd, the carrying of His cross, to His death and burial. This is a powerful recalling of the events which are at the heart of our faith.
