Daniel 7: 9-10, 13-14

An everlasting Kingship

Daniel has a vision of 'one like a human being' coming with the clouds of heaven - one to whom glory and kingship will be given. All peoples, nations and languages shall serve him and 'his kingship' is one that shall never be destroyed.

Revelation 1: 4b-8

To Him who loves us and freed us, be glory for ever

In this passage the greatness of Jesus is expressed - His love, His giving of Himself to free mankind from sin and also His eternal glory. He has made us a people, a kingdom, serving God who is His Father and our Father. When He comes all will see Him. For some that will bring judgement. The writer outlines a vision of His universal power extending throughout all time and space.

John 18: 33-37

Born to be King



When questioned by Pilate as to whether He was a king, Jesus told him that He was born to be a king but that His Kingdom is not from this world - not based on conflict to gain power, but on truth. His followers are those who believe that truth and listen to His voice.
