Isaiah here tells of God's great love for His people. He reassures them that when they pass through difficult times they will not be overwhelmed. They are precious to Him and He will be with them.

Acts 8: 14-17

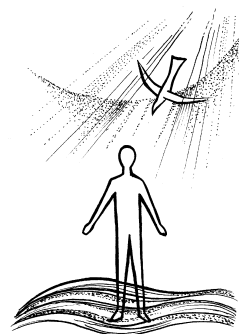
Apostles lay hands on the people of Samaria

People in Samaria had been baptised but had not yet received the Holy Spirit. Peter and John were sent by the other apostles from Jerusalem to Samaria and, after praying for them, they laid hands on those who had been baptised in the name of Jesus. They then also received the Holy Spirit.

Luke 3: 15-17, 21-22

Jesus is Baptised

The people coming to John the Baptist to be baptised were questioning whether John himself might be the expected Messiah. John, however, told them of the One, much greater than himself, who was coming and who would baptise them with the Holy Spirit and with fire - and who would be their judge. When Jesus Himself comes to be baptised, while He was praying, the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove, comes and settles on Him. A voice from heaven proclaims Him to be God's beloved Son. From this time the mission of Jesus, Saviour of the World, begins.
